We held a residents meeting recently where the issue of the Paragon Hotel housing 400 asylum seekers was raised and discussed. I took the concerns of residents to the Minister for Immigration to ask for a proper explanation about the housing of 400 asylum seekers in the Paragon Hotel earlier this year. I am aware that there are far far fewer asylum seekers now housed there and that there has been a concerted effort to improve the conditions for those asylum seekers who are temporarily housed there.

I will be holding another residents meeting on Friday 9th of December from 2:30pm to 3:30pm at St Albans Academy, Conybere St, Highgate, Birmingham B12 0YH. I do hope that you can come so that I may update you on the Paragon Hotel and other local issues.
